This month's report will focus on the North-central state of Kaduna which suffered a series of attacks over the entire month.



The state is located at the Northern part of Nigeria's high plains. The vegetation cover is Sudan Savannah type, characterized by scattered short trees, shrubs and grasses, it is bordered by 7 states(Niger, Katsina, Kano, Bauchi, Plateau, Nassarawa and Abuja), and is ranked 4th in size and 3rd by population. It consists of 23 LGAs.





The pattern of attacks indicates their aim is to sow terror amongst the populace and kidnap people for ransom, all classes of society are affected rich and poor, regardless of religious divide. Their obvious target is commercial gain through kidnap ransom and to discredit government by terrorizing the civilians.

The thick shrubby vegetation that is characteristic of Kaduna is continuous with adjoining states of Niger, Zaria and Katsina, thus giving these criminal groups sufficient forest cover to set up camps in the bush from which they freely operate.

Recent joint operations by Nigeria's Air and Land forces to arrest the activities of these bandits in Zamfara and Katsina have led to heavy losses on their side, thus forcing them to relocate southwards into Kaduna and Niger states where they continue their reign of terror seemingly unchallenged.

It is our humble suggestion to the government and security agencies, that the developments in Kaduna call for a state of emergency to be instated in Kaduna and joint clearing operations currently being carried out in adjoining states be ramped up to include Niger and Kaduna states.

Despite the frequency of these attacks, Kaduna remains a thriving commercial center, our travel advisory is to avoid travel to the state unless where absolutely necessary, and in such cases to limit movement to within the city of Kaduna as much as possible.

N.B Our data is sourced from open source documents of newspaper dailies, security trackers e.t.cand has not been independently verified .

There continues to be civilian and military casualties in several other theaters of conflict within Nigeria, especially in the Northwest, Northeast and Southeast. We will be providing updates.
